We have found that by following the steps below you can maximize student's learning and engagement with Skritter:

Demonstrate how to use Skritter in class.



The most important functions to demo are as follows: selecting vocabulary, practicing, and "snap" versus "raw squigs" practice modes (basically more versus less help when writing characters).

Show students that Skritter supports their textbook.
